This proposal is a lasting tribute to the populace of the Barony of Britannia, a great and noble Barony of the Kingdom of Camelot. These coronets celebrate the Barony of Britannia and seeks to increase the drama and courtly presence of the barony. I draw my inspiration from the heraldry and existing regalia of the Barony of Britannia so that this design is part of the whole courtly presentation of Barons and Baronesses who will now, and in the future wear these as the ceremonial leaders of this great Barony in the stellar kingdom of Camelot.

Lastly, I will create coronets that are compact and easily transported and be of a comfortable fit to those who sit as Baron and Baroness Britannia, now and in the future.

The overall structure: Each crown is composed of 6 hinged plaques.

The dimensions of the Baronial Coronets will 50 millimeters (2 inches) total height and will be 24 $\frac{5}{8}$ " overall circumference, and 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ " overall circumference. The Baronial Coronets will include a sewn in place fabric lining this will allow for a customized fit for any wearer inside the set circumference. This liner is intended to be removed and replaced periodically.

The rear plaque will be removable so that shorter or longer plaques can be added to size them. 2 additional plaques will be provided for each Coronet.

The largest and forward-facing plaque will have the Baronial device on the front. "a pair of Wyverns guarding the jewel of the Nile". On the top of the coronets will be 6 spheres in white.

The blue gems will be in bezels that are removable for maintenance. The design will be based on the history of Britannia and Camelot.

Cost to make two coronets with 6 plaques, 6 gems, and 2 cast wyverns. 2 extra plaques for sizing.
